- To promote the work of the group through active encouragement and dissemination of individual and collaborative initiatives
- To ensure educational progression opportunities, particularly to FE and HE are promoted and accessible to all care experienced young people
- To use the network email list to share research projects and other related literature and opportunities

Meetings are convened by the Inspiring Choices programme, who are responsible for chairing the meetings and circulating informal meeting notes.
