
## 11 stakeholders responded to our survey when we asked..

- If they would consider continuing to fund any activity if / when Uni Connect ends












They really get a lot out of these workshops as they feel it's related to something they are going to need Would you change or improve an activity?






## Funding bids

If Uni Connect funding ends would you consider funding the intervention again


Unfortunately not as we don't have the funds. This funding is essential and impacts many young people's lives This helps them to explore and learn more about careers in general and about their own career thoughts independently




The software has allowed us to track students progress of careers engagement in school.










### **Summary and recommendations**

### From the 11 stakeholders who have completed this survey...

### **General**:

- Inspiring Choices work with stakeholders with a wide range of job titles including: Engagement Manager, Virtual School Headteacher, Head of Pastoral Curriculum & Careers, and Service Families Liaison Officer
- Our stakeholders work in York (45%), Scarborough (27%), Whitby (9%), Selby (9%) and across the UK (9%)
- 36% of stakeholders have worked with Inpsiring Choices for over four years
- 60% of responses strongly agreed that they understand the aims of Inspiring Choices, Inspiring Choices has added value to their organisation, is effective in their communication, and that the program focuses on the priorities in their local area
- Stakeholders expressed a lack of funds to run and support workshops if Inspiring Choices' funding was to end
- Stakeholders praised Inspiring Choices for 'making a big difference to many student lives and aspirations on the Yorkshire coast' and as 'oustanding for the opportunities and grants as well as support they have offered us'
- Stakeholders reported no suggestions for how to change or improve any of the activites
- CV and cover letter writing as well as mock interviews were mentioned by stakeholders when asked what else they would like us to offer. We have faciliate both of these so please get in touch if you are interested.



### Summary and recommendations

### From the 11 stakeholders who have completed this survey...

### **Inspiring Choices led activity:**

- What is HE? (20%), beginers guide to HE (20%) and careers fairs (20%) were the most commonly reported **Inspiring Choices led activities**
- Employability and HE assembly were reported as the most successful Inspiring Choices led activities as students 'feel it's related to something they are going to need'.

### **Funding bids:**


